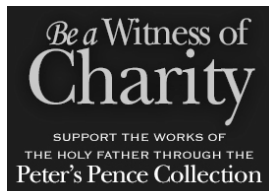

The air conditioner in the Parish Center can no longer be serviced and needs to be replaced. The boiler at Immaculate Conception Chapel and the plowing truck also need to be replaced before the winter season.
