41ST ANNUAL CANAL WALK FOR HAITI will be held on Good Friday, April 14, along the service road of the Cape Cod Canal in Buzzards Bay, Mass. For 40 years participants from Cape Cod and Eastern Massachusetts have been walking 10 km along this scenic route to raise funds and awareness of worthwhile humanitarian projects in Haiti sponsored by local organizations. The walk begins at the Buzzards Bay railroad bridge parking lot at 9:00 a.m., rain or shine, and proceeds 5 km along the Army Corps of Engineers service road (no vehicular traffic) to the Herring Run Visitors Center. Hot and cold drinks, sandwiches, and fruit are available free of charge for walkers. Port-a-Potties are open for the convenience of walkers. The walk then continues back along the same route to the original starting location. Walkers are asked to secure pledges or donations from family and friends. For Our Lady of the Cape walkers, make checks out to: Our Lady of the Cape. We invite anyone who wishes to participate in assisting our sisters and brothers in Haiti, during this time of reconstruction and recovery, to walk with us in solidarity with the Haitian people on Good Friday, April 14. Stations of the Cross pamphlets will be given to all walkers. Walkers are encouraged to read and meditate on each station in remembrance of the meaning of Good Friday. Divine Mercy

We will be holding our parish Divine Mercy celebration on Sunday, April 23, the Feast of the Divine Mercy. This Feast



comes to us from St. Faustina. In her diary, later published as the book, *The Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska: Divine Mercy in My Soul*, Jesus asked for a feast day to celebrate his infinite love and forgiveness for each of us. Pope St. John Paul II instituted this feast to take place on the Sunday after Easter each year.

By receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Eucharist on the Feast, Jesus grants the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. Our souls are made as pure as at Baptism.

Our parish celebration of Divine Mercy will take place as follows on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 23rd:

Confessions from 2:00 – 3:00 PM Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 2:45 PM Recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:00 PM.

Also, the novena to the Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday. We will pray the novena together each day following daily Mass during the week of Easter.

We hope that you will join us for a beautiful and powerful celebration of the mercy of God!
