NEXT SUNDAY, APRIL 23, DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY:



Come and participate in this beautiful feast in which we celebrate and receive the infinite love and mercy of God!

This is a relatively new feast of the Catholic Church. During the course of Jesus' revelations to St. Faustina on Divine Mercy, Jesus asked on numerous occasions that a feast be dedicated to the Divine Mercy on the Sunday after Easter. Pope John Paul II instituted the feast at the canonization of St. Faustina in April 2000.

St. Faustina was a Polish sister of Our Lady of Mercy who lived from 1905 to 1938. Throughout her life, Faustina reported having visions of Jesus and conversations with him, which she wrote about in her diary, later published as the book, *The Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska: Divine Mercy in My Soul.*

Concerning the Feast of Divine Mercy, Jesus said, "Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary 300) Accordingly, all who attend Mass and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Divine Mercy Sunday will receive great spiritual benefit.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy was given by Jesus to St. Faustina. The Chaplet is a series of prayers that are prayed on rosary beads. Pamphlets are available at the church entrances with directions as to how to pray. You can also consult www.divinemercy.org for instructions.
