Divine Mercy

We will be holding our parish Divine Mercy celebration on Sunday, April 23, the Feast of the Divine Mercy. This Feast comes to

us from St. Faustina. In her diary, later published as the book, *The Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska: Divine Mercy in My Soul*, Jesus asked for a feast day to celebrate his infinite love and forgiveness for each of us. Pope St. John Paul II instituted this feast to take place on the Sunday after Easter each year.

By receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Eucharist on the Feast, Jesus grants the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. Our souls are made as pure as at Baptism.

Our parish celebration of Divine Mercy will take place as follows on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 23rd:

Confessions from 2:00 – 3:00 PM
Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at
2:45 PM
Recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy
at 3:00 PM.

Also, the novena to the Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday. We will pray the novena together each day following daily Mass during the week of Easter.

We hope that you will join us for a beautiful and powerful celebration of the mercy of God!
