Word from **Our Pastor**



Thank you. You have touched my life in the most vulnerable moment as I shared my grief over the sudden death of three members of my family-Honey, my niece (30 years), her only child Aaron (2 years) and her mother-in-law Theresa (62 years). Thank you for the outpouring of empathy, prayers, hugs, and words of support. Indeed we are a compassionate family.

Honey was the only daughter of my sister Mary. She was gifted with Aaron after ten years of married life. A few years ago, my sister lost her husband, Anthony, to cardiac arrest. It must really be hard for this family to lose their dad, and now the only daughter and her only son. Ever since they lost their dad, my sister Mary and her son Nipun (studying for nursing) and Honey looked up to me as their "father" and I have been fortunate to extend support to their family. Belby, Honey's husband, and the only survivor from this car accident lost his dad two months ago. This is the fourth death in the same family within the last two months.

I felt so heartbroken for not being with them at this tragic time and at the funeral Mass that gathered more than a thousand people! Once again, it reminded me of the cost of discipleship, being a priest far away from home, which I often take for granted.

In the tradition of Catholic Church in India, around the ninth day of death, family and friends gather to offer a Memorial Mass, followed by a reception to celebrate life. I am planning to travel to India on June 11th to offer this Mass on the 13th for the three departed beloved of my family and offer some support to the grieving family. Thank you for your support and kind gestures in this difficult time.
