### DIOCESAN ASSESSMENT:

The diocesan assessment that was introduced in 2016 helps to support Diocese's central operations, including the offices of the Bishop. Chancery, Finance, Insurance, Legal, Tribunal. Communications, Pro-Life and other support areas. Recently Diocesan Review Committee met to suggest improvements to the current assessment. The committee recommended and the Bishop has approved that beginning July 2017, the new assessment for each parish will be reduced, in good faith, across all parishes 1% . For us at Our Lady of the Cape it means that the assessment will be reduced from 14% to 13% of our offertory income.

#### *IV. Prayerful Ways of Approaching Your Labyrinth Walk:*

St. Augustine is known to have said, “It is solved by walking.” The goal of walking and praying on the labyrinth is connecting with Jesus. The key to getting as much as possible out of time spent walking and praying on the labyrinth is to remain open to the working of the Holy Spirit.

There are as many ways to walk and pray the labyrinth as there are people. Howsoever you choose to interact with Jesus as you walk, you are doing it “the right way.” There is only one path. You follow it to the center, spend time in the center and follow it back out.

A few possible approaches you may take to your time in prayer, whether in or outside of the labyrinth space are:

- Asking a question: bring a decision that must be made to Jesus, saying for example, “Jesus, I am wondering what to do next in my life?”
- Honoring a benchmark: bring a significant date or transition, saying for example, “Thank you, Jesus, for a new opportunity,” or “Thank you for the gift of this special person” on her or his birthday.
- Reflection: reflect on your life or on something that is concerning you right now, asking for example, “Jesus, what do you want me to know? What are you saying to me through this situation?”
- Repetition: repeat a mantra or phrase over and over as a way of entering into meditation, for example, ‘come Holy Spirit, come,’ or repeat a spiritual word that has significance for you, such as, ‘love, love, love...’
- Help: asking for help for self or others, saying for example, “Jesus, I walk to ask you for help for so and so...”

Come and visit our newly updated parish prayer garden, complete with new labyrinth! We will bless the garden and labyrinth on Sunday, August 6, following the 10:00 a.m. Mass. A short reception will follow and a group labyrinth walk will be offered for all who are interested. Plan to join us as we give thanks to God for the many blessings in our lives!
