The Diocese of Fall River has announced that a preparation program for adults who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation will be offered on the Cape during March. Deacon Bruce Bonneau will be leading sessions at Corpus Christi Parish in Sandwich on March 4, 11 and 18 from 1:30 to 4:30 PM.

A requirement of the program is a day of retreat, which is planned for Saturday, April 21 at St. John Neumann Parish in Freetown, MA from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM, and will be on the theme of *Maturing in Faith.* Conferral of the sacrament will take place on Saturday, May 12 at St. Mary's Cathedral in Fall River at 4:00 PM.

If you are an adult and have not yet been confirmed, please prayerfully consider whether this is the right time for you to prepare to receive the sacrament. Should you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to discuss them with our pastoral staff.
