## Teachers needed for 2018-19!

We are looking for people to share their faith with our youth. No experience necessary. Our program is very flexible with opportunities to team teach.

Our program is structured to meet the needs of families and each age group.

- Babysitting will be offered during the 8:30 Mass.
- Kindergarten & 1<sup>st</sup> grade will be offered during the 8:30 Mass and Mondays 4-5:30PM. It is a lectionary based program with weekly pamphlets and heavily supplemented with age appropriate videos, stories and simple projects. Completion of the first grade is required for the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade first communion program.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade uses a text book & video program called Blessed. It is very easy to follow. The first half of the year prepares the students for First Reconciliation. The second half of the year prepares the students for First Communion. Students will be dismissed from Faith on Fire right after donuts for their normal class rather than attending the whole Faith on Fire session. Second grade will be offered on Sunday mornings 9:30-11AM and Monday afternoons 4-5:30.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade is a lectionary based program with weekly pamphlets and supplemented with projects and videos. Classes are offered on Sunday mornings 9:30-11AM and Monday afternoons 4-5:30.
- 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades are combined and use a lectionary based program supplemented with videos and projects, especially our annual Seder Passover Meal during Lent. Classes are offered on Sunday mornings 9:30-11AM and Monday afternoons 4-5:30.
- New Middle School Program (grades 6,7,8)! This is the plan so far, but still a work in progress.
  - Students will be take 2 core courses per year and 4 electives.
  - The year will be broken down into 3 seasons with registration at the beginning of each season with core courses offered each season.
  - Electives will typically be @ 3 hours, broken into 1 or 2 sessions. i.e. Rosary elective- learn about, make and pray the rosary.
  - Flexibility for teachers! Teachers could teach 1, 2 or all 3 seasons and/or electives in the season of their choosing. Teachers may sign up to teach a topic they are passionate about - we have some ideas but welcome any proposals!
  - Days & times offered will be Sundays and varying days/times during the week depending on the season and when teachers are available.
- Confirmation I Chosen program. Offered Sundays 9:30-11 and Monday evenings.
- Confirmation II Chosen program, run by Priscilla and facilitated by teen peer leaders. Sundays 11:30 Mass, Session 12:30-2:30
