## **PASTORAL COUNCIL NEWS!**

**Pastoral Council Membership:** Following the revised By-laws of the Pastoral Council a Nominating Committee was selected at the recent Pastoral Council meeting. The Nominating Committee is now inviting parishioners to submit names of qualified and willing parishioners to serve on the Pastoral Council of Our Lady of the Cape Parish, beginning in September. The potential candidates will have a time of discernment and prayer in August before they will be commissioned at one of the Masses in September. The term of four members selected to the Council will be for three years and the term of another four members selected will be for two years.

### **Considerations for Names of Nominees to the Council:**

1. Person interested in serving in the ministry of parish leadership on the Council should have the ability to pray, study matters, and to reflect upon them thoroughly so as to make sound recommendations to the Pastor.
2. Person should be a registered Catholic parishioner, active participant in the Eucharistic life of the parish, and contribute time, talent and treasure.
3. Persons should have the following characteristics: desire for spiritual growth; enthusiasm about the future direction of our parish; willingness to listen, speak honestly, and work toward consensus; ability to inspire and empower others; flexibility and openness.
