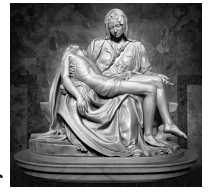

PRESENTATION ON MICHELANGELO'S PIETA:

We are delighted to announce that Dr. Esperanca Camara, Professor of Art History at the University of St. Francis in Ft. Wayne, IN, will be at Our Lady of the Cape to give a presentation on sacred art on **Tuesday, July 31** at 9:30 a.m. Her program is entitled, **"Meditations in Stone: Michelangelo's Pieta."**



Michelangelo's *Pieta*, now housed in St. Peter's in Rome, is one of the most famous works of art ever made. This exceptionally beautiful sculpture marked the beginning of Michelangelo's life-long meditation on Christ's death and the Virgin's suffering.

This presentation examines his deeply personal and theologically-rich reflections on this theme, and invites the audience to experience the visual arts as inspiration for prayer and meditation.

Dr. Camara specializes in Catholic devotional art. She received her M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Johns Hopkins University, where she studied Italian 16th- and 17th- century art. **Come and join us for a very enriching experience!**
