NEW PASTORAL COUNCIL

Over the last two years Our Lady of the Cape Parish Council members have diligently dedicated their time revising the Parish Council By-Laws that were many years old and working toward moving from a Parish Council model to a Pastoral Council model. I thank them for their service and guidance. The Parish Council model included representatives from different organizations, staff members and appointed members. They invested a great deal of their time in reporting what has been happening and in “doing” activities in the parish.

The new Pastoral Council is a Leadership Body who leads the parish community in discerning the present and future direction of the parish, as well as, calling forth those gifted to serve in that capacity. The new model calls for a collaborative ministry model that is based on consensus building. It is a consultative body to the pastor. By visioning the Mission of the parish, in prayer and discernment, they are tasked to develop a Pastoral Plan for the parish and increase Lay participation in various ministries.

The composition of this new group was born out of the discernment of the out-going Parish Council members and by open invitation through the bulletin announcements. A second discernment process was put in place by the Nominating Committee. Then, those potential candidates were approached and asked about their willingness to serve and join in a time of discernment, prayer and reflection held on August 29 at 6:30 p.m. At the end of that session each one expressed their commitment to serve our parish as members of the Pastoral Council. Following the By-Laws, twelve members of the Pastoral Council will be commissioned at 10:00 a.m. Mass on **Sunday, September 9th**. I thank them for their availability and willingness to serve and lead our parish family to a more vibrant and spiritual experience.
