## **A LETTER FROM OUR BISHOP:**

### **Dear Brothers and Sisters:**

Bishops of the United States are joining together in a commitment of prayer and reparation leading up to our general assembly, where we will be making critical decisions in response to the clergy sexual abuse crisis. With my brother bishops across the nation, I will be dedicating myself to seven days of intensified prayer and fasting, from Monday, November 5, through Sunday, November 11. The intentions for this period of prayer and sacrifice are three fold:

- For the healing and support of all victims of clergy sexual abuse.
- For the conversion and just punishment of the perpetrators and concealers of sexual abuse.
- For the strength of the bishops to be holy shepherds in protecting and leading our sheep from all harm.

If you feel called to do so, you are welcome to join me in praying for these intentions. I would also be grateful for any prayers for me and my brother bishops during our general assembly, that we may follow the guidance of the Holy Spirit in responding to the tragedy of clergy sexual abuse in the Church.

Please be assured of my prayers for you, for your intentions, and for all the good and faithful people of our beloved Diocese of Fall River. May the Lord assist us and guide us to act with wisdom and justice, to do what is right and true and walk humbly with our God.

**MISSION TRIP TO HAITI:** This coming **March (2019)** we are planning to take a group of teens on a mission trip to Haiti. They will be doing work at our sister parish in Dessalines, Haiti, as well as interacting with the local school children and seeing the living conditions in the surrounding area. Experiencing the hardships and way of life in a third world country will profoundly affect the teen's view of the world. Truly a life changing experience! The cost of the trip would be approximately \$10,000 for 10 people, \$1,000 per student. The cost includes plane fare, lodging, food, transportation in Haiti, transportation to & from Logan airport and other miscellaneous expenses. This is a costly trip for a student, but the experience is priceless. This trip will not only affect the teen but how the teen affects the future of the world he/she lives in.
