OUR LADY OF THE CAPE ADVENT PROGRAMS AND EVENTS:

Advent is around the corner, and begins on the weekend of **December 1-2**. We hope that you take advantage of the upcoming programs and events we are offering at Our Lady of the Cape to deepen our faith and prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of Jesus.

- Each **Wednesday** morning of Advent, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament immediately following the 8:00 a.m. daily Mass. We will gather to pray for the renewal of our parish and an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
- On **Sunday, December 2**, at the 8:30 a.m. Mass, all young children along with their parents and/or grandparents are invited to receive a special blessing during Mass. Following Mass, they are invited to have donuts with Santa and do a craft activity in the lower level of the church. Bring your phone or camera to snap a pic!
- On **Monday, December 3**, we will commemorate the recent canonization of St. Oscar Romero, the Archbishop of San Salvador who spoke out against poverty and social injustice, with a special viewing of the movie, **Romero**. The event begins at noon in the parish center hall, and all are asked to bring a brown bag lunch. Fr. Joe Towle, a Maryknoll missionary priest who has served extensively in Latin America and South America, will introduce the movie and give us important background info. You won't want to miss it!
- On **Wednesday, December 12**, there will be an Advent Book Discussion Group. We will meet from 9:30 to 10:45 a.m. and discuss the book, **The Hiding Place** by Corrie ten Boom. This deeply moving story describes the journey of generosity, faith, suffering and forgiveness on the part of a World War II concentration camp survivor who was imprisoned for hiding Jews.
