MAJOR CHURCH PROJECTS

Immaculate Conception Chapel:

This spring we are completing some major improvements and repairs to the Immaculate Conception Chapel in East Brewster. The chapel is now fully air-conditioned and the old electric system was upgraded from 100 amps to 300 amps. The interior of the chapel is also being painted. Last year we installed new carpets.

Thanks to the Ocean Edge Resort in Brewster and Joe Corcoran and family, who have helped complete this project with amazing generosity. Besides this most generous donation, every year they donate the Ocean Edge Golf Course for Our Lady of the Cape's annual Giving Back Golf Open. Thanks for their continuing friendship with the Missionaries of La Salette from whom the Corcoran's purchased the present Ocean Edge (old seminary) and for their love of Our Lady of the Cape community.

Our Lady of the Cape:

Due to the poor drainage system in the back area of the church, rainwater has been infiltrating through the foundation walls into the main electrical panels of the Church. A recent study conducted by Coastal Engineering concluded that we have to open up the ground behind the church area and add more drainage, seal the leaks, and repair the electric panels before a disaster might strike us. The Bishop of Fall River has immediately approved the project and allowed us to withdraw the cost of this project (approximately \$95,000.00) from our Saving Account with the diocese, a request made by the parish Finance Council. A part of the savings account we had for rainy days!

Please be patient during this major project that is scheduled to begin by May 15, lasting until the end of June. There will be a few weekday Masses where we may not have power in the church.

All handicap parking and access from behind the church will be suspended during the project. Additional handicap parking will be provided on the upper level of the parking lot. If you have difficulty with walking, we encourage you to use the lower level parking lot on the side and use the elevator to the church.
