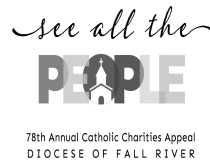

Cape Cod Residents:

Were you shocked when New York recently adopted unrestricted abortion, including late-term abortion and even infanticide---the killing of an infant?

Now, Massachusetts legislators are poised to pass a bill just as extreme!

The bill is labeled S.1209: "An act to remove obstacles and expand abortion access."

This measure would:

- **Allow killing of unborn children right up to delivery;**
- **Eliminate parents' (or at least a judge's) consent for minors, no matter how young, to undergo abortions;**
- **Permit late-term abortions to be performed outside of hospitals, thus endangering women;**
- **Increase taxpayer funding of abortion by diverting existing monies from a program aimed at reducing infant deaths among the poor;**
- **Eliminate all criminal penalties for those who perform abortions and are NOT doctors.**

By contrast, our twin goals are counseling pregnant women about alternative options to abortion and comforting those who have lost a child to abortion.
