SUMMER SPEAKER SERIES:
On **Tuesday, August 6,** we will host Mary MacGilivray, for our third speaker series event of the summer.

Her talk is entitled **'Celtic Spirituality.'** Mary is a spiritual director and retreat leader, as well as chaplain at Spaulding Rehab Hospital. She is also a former Theology teacher from Arlington Catholic High School. In addition to Celtic Spirituality, her areas of study include addictions, healing and the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius.

Mary will as give us an overview of the history of the Celtic spirituality and expand our understanding of the Celtic spiritual tradition. She will discuss the three patron saints of Ireland - Patrick, Brigit and Columcille - and lead us in three Celtic spiritual practices of the prayer of blessing, peregrinatio and encircling prayer.
