ICE CREAM SOCIAL FOR HAITI,

Friday, August 23: Did you know that for 30 years OLC has had a sister parish in Haiti? It is St. Claire's in Dessalines about 30 miles from Port au Prince. Did you know that we helped establish five schools and give lunch to over 3,000 Haitian school children?

The Together with Haiti Ministry will hold their annual Ice Cream Social on **Friday, August 23,** 7:00-8:30 p.m. in the parish center.

This year has been a particularly difficult one for Haiti. Civil unrest and violence has made things worse for our sister parish, St. Claire's. As you may remember, the violence stopped the youth group of Our Lady of the Cape to travel on their mission trip in March. None of our religious were able to travel from Haiti to join us for our ice cream social this year.

An urgent message in July from Fr. Mami, one of our La Salette missionaries, says "The situation in Haiti is getting worse day by day. The country has been locked down for four months the markets, stores, and administration offices are almost all closed ... living is expensive ... the population lives in the fear and mistrust ... Those who can are rushing to leave ... Despite everything we are safe. Pray for this country and for our mission."

This year at the social we will learn about the situation in Haiti from two parishioners who operate an orphanage in Port au Prince and who have visited recently. Fr. William will share his PowerPoint on what your contributions have been able to do for St. Claire's parish community, and some representatives from the youth group will talk about the cancelled mission trip. We have Haitian drummers providing music, some beautiful Haitian art to raffle, and, oh yes, you can eat ice cream!
