CHANGE IN SECOND COLLECTIONS: After due consultation with the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, we are making a slight change in the manner of taking Second Collections for the needs of the Universal Church. Beginning January 2020, you will have three ways to contribute to these collections which will be published a week before in the bulletin.



You can contribute: **1.** By subscribing to the weekly envelopes (free) through the parish office; **2.** By signing up on Online Giving and direct pay (we will be happy to help you set it up); **3.** By picking up Second Collection Envelopes (lavender color) located in the pews. Before each Mass there will be an announcement to advise you if there will be a separate Second Collection taken or if your contribution to the Second Collection should be placed in the First Collection basket. (Similar to SVDP collection).



HELP TO THE MISSIONS IN HAITI:

In a recent meeting of “Together with Haiti” we have approved sending funds for school lunches, tuition fees and

scholarships to St. Claire Lumiere and Fabias schools \$6,200.00; St. Maria Goretti and Immaculate Conception schools \$7,000.00; St. Augustine school \$3,000.00 for the months of March- June 2020.

Last December we were able to complete the project of digging wells in two villages of Dessalines for clean water. This year we are sending \$14,000.00 to begin the project of digging two new wells in the villages of Bayonnais.

We are also responding to the request of Salesian sisters who are running a dispensary for the poor to install solar panels that is estimated to cost \$30,000.00.

This month we will be sending \$60,200.00 to Haiti.

For the school year 2019-2020 Our Lady of the Cape has sent a total of \$96,100.00 to the missions in Haiti. I am thankful for your generous support of our brothers and sisters in Haiti. Thank you very much.

The situation in Haiti is still concerning and fearful. It is a broken country: the poorest in the western hemisphere, its people traumatized by the shattering earthquake which destroyed so many lives, and prey to a devastating cholera epidemic and continuing violence. The new crime wave, which is being amplified by unconfirmed reports on social media of abductions of schoolchildren, churchgoers and the poor, is creating panic among Haitians.

One of the La Salette priests, Fr. Mami wrote: “Now they have stopped the demonstrations and the barricades but they are kidnapping people. Students, children, foreigners, priests and the religious are targeted. Please continue to pray for the people of Haiti.” Thank you.



I also take this opportunity to thank the members of “Together with Haiti Ministry.” *Well done.*

I am also grateful to the Giving Back Golf Committee for raising a substantial amount to support the clean water project in Haiti.
