CHANGE IN SECOND COLLECTIONS: After due consultation with the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, we are making a slight change in the manner of taking Second Collections for the needs of the Universal Church. Beginning January 2020, you will have three ways to contribute to these collections which will be published a week before in the bulletin.

You can contribute: **1.** By subscribing to the weekly envelopes (free) through the parish office; **2.** By signing up on Online Giving and direct pay (we will be happy to help you set it up); **3.** By picking up Second Collection Envelopes (lavender color) located in the pews. Before each Mass there will be an announcement to advise you if there will be a separate Second Collection taken or if your contribution to the Second Collection should be placed in the First Collection basket. (Similar to SVDP collection).



CORONAVIRUS; PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES:

I take this opportunity to convey a few precautionary measures we are taking amid public health concerns regarding the spread of the coronavirus:

1. Suspending the use of holy water at the entrances of the Church.
2. Suspending the exchange of the sign of peace and instructing that it be exchanged without physical contact.
3. Urging priests and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion to practice good hygiene, washing their hands before Mass begins or even using an alcohol based anti-bacterial solution before and after distributing Holy Communion
4. Assuring the faithful that if you are sick or are experiencing symptoms of sickness are not obliged to attend Mass, and even that out of charity you ought not to attend.
5. Urging to pray for those who are suffering in the current outbreak of sickness and praying for scientists, health professionals and public officials that they will be filled with wisdom and understanding.
