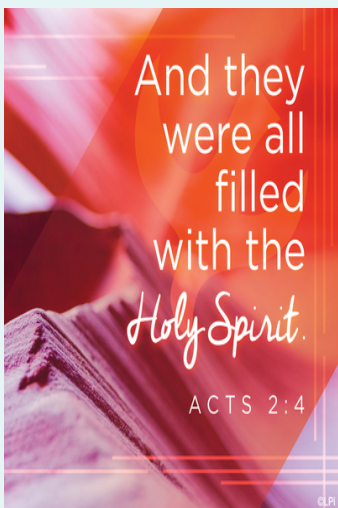

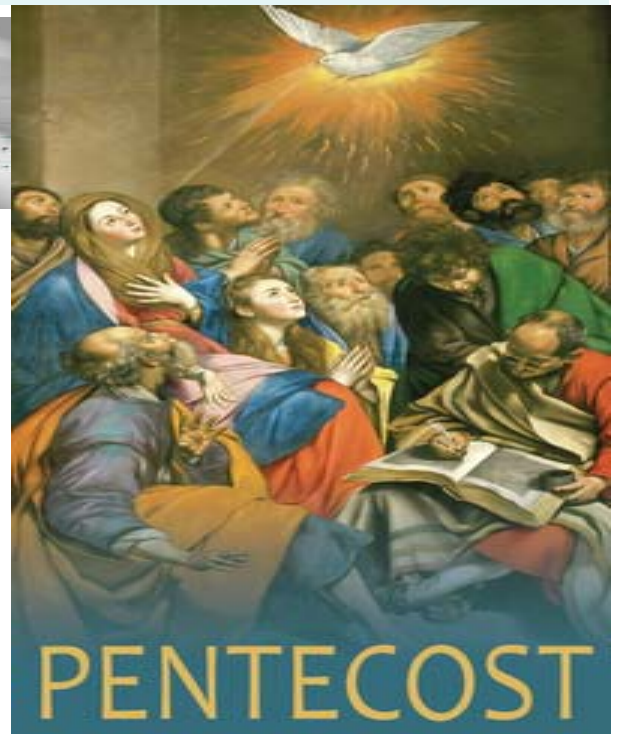
### Prayer to Our Lady of La Salette In Pandemic Time

## **MAKE HAND SANITIZER!**



**Making hand sanitizer is easy to do and only requires a few ingredients:**

- 1) 2/3 Cup isopropyl or rubbing alcohol (99 percent alcohol volume)
- 2) 1/3 Cup aloe vera gel
- 3) optional: a few drops of an essential oil, such as tea tree oil, peppermint oil or lavender oil, or you can use lemon juice instead

- Make the hand sanitizer in a clean space. Wipe down countertops with a diluted bleach solution beforehand.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before making the hand sanitizer.
- Don't touch the mixture with your hands until it's ready for use.

### **Instructions**

1. In a small bowl mix the rubbing alcohol and aloe vera gel together until well combined.
2. Optional: add in just a few drops of essential oil of your choice.

## PUBLIC MASSES TO RESUME ON THE WEEKEND OF MAY 30th/31st

In preparation of re-opening the church and out of an abundance of caution, beginning the weekend of May 30/31st weekend Masses at Our Lady of the Cape church are scheduled for 4:00PM on Saturday and Sunday at 10:00AM only. Daily Mass will be celebrated Monday to Friday at 8:00AM.

The Immaculate Conception Chapel will remain closed until further notice. All the Masses will be live-streamed and will be archived on our parish website ([www.ourladyofthecape.org](http://www.ourladyofthecape.org)) for you to access anytime. If you are not feeling comfortable to come to Mass on a weekend, try a weekday Mass and avoid the crowd.

Every Sunday afternoon from 1:30PM -2:00PM Holy Communion will be distributed in the church for those who have joined the live stream Mass and those who would be at risk or are still justifiably uncomfortable being in the crowds for any length of time.

The obligation to participate in Sunday Mass is still lifted by Bishop da Cunha, whose utmost concern is the health and wellbeing of our parishioners. Therefore, those who are feeling ill, or who have symptoms of fever, dry cough or sore throat should not come out to Mass but watch live streamed Mass from home.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available on Saturdays from 3:00 to 3:45PM. Following the strict observance of social distancing it will be offered in the vestry at the main entrance of the church.

Following the Governor's ordinance (40% capacity), at Our Lady of the Cape we can accommodate 340 people at each service. But, six feet social distancing would allow us to have only around 225 seating at one service. For everyone's safety we will adhere to the social distancing regulation and allow only 225 people at one service. Seating will be on a first come first served basis. Not all pews of the church will be open for seating. Every other pew will be blocked off. Please be patient and considerate when you see that your favorite pew is taken by someone else or blocked off.

The church is prepared with signage to direct people. The aisles and pews are marked to facilitate the observance of social distancing practices. After each Mass the church will be sanitized. Volunteers are needed to help with the task of sanitizing after Mass on Saturday and Sunday. There will be a rehearsal meeting of volunteers on May 29, Friday at 6:00PM in the church.

### Entrance and Exit

- A face mask must be worn at all times including entering and exiting the church and throughout the liturgy with the brief exception of removing it to receive communion.
- Sanitize your hands as soon as you enter the church. Sanitizers will be provided. But you are most welcome to bring your own sanitizers and wipes.
- As you enter the church please occupy the front pews first; Ushers will direct you to your seat.
- After you have received Holy Communion, communicants exit the church using the side aisle and following the six feet social distancing.

### Ministries and Participation

- Only the Cantor will be allowed to sing in order to prevent the virus being aerosolized during singing by the congregation.
- There will neither be a solemn entrance procession nor a recessional by the celebrant and ministers.
- Neither Eucharistic Ministers nor Altar Servers will be needed.
- The Lector will be seated at their designated seat prior to the Mass.
- The sign of peace will be shared without physical contact.
- The collection baskets will be kept at the entrances of the church rather than passed during the Masses. Thank you for your continued financial generosity.

### Holy Communion

- Holy Communion will be distributed after the final Blessing. After you have received Holy Communion you are required to exit the church, following the social distancing.
- The Communion procession will be only in one line at each wing of the church and will be regulated by keeping the social distance.
- Communicants should come one row at a time beginning with the first row and return to your cars using the side aisles.
- Communion can be received only in the hand from the Priest who will gently drop the consecrated host in your hand. Please step away from the Priest to consume the Body of Christ by lifting your face mask and please respond "Amen" silently.
- During this soft opening of the Church, only the priests will be distributing Holy Communion. When pastoral need arises, we will ask help of the extra ordinary ministers to the Eucharist.

**All other parish activities other than celebration of Masses will remain suspended at this time until further notice. The parish office remains closed to the public.
